

Education programmes eligible for exemption from trade test.

The following education programmes qualify for exemption from the trade test.¹

- Retail butcher
- Baker
- Confectioner
- Chocolate and confectionery assistant
- Fresh-food assistant
- Chef, sandwich maid, caterer, etc. (gastronomy training programme)
- Waiter
- Sales assistant
- Shop assistant training programme
- Wholesale and trading assistant
- Hotel and leisure assistant
- Kitchen assistant
- Dairy worker/ dairy technician
- Receptionist
- Catering officer
- Cafeteria and canteen assistant
- Service economist specialising in hotel and restaurant management
- Profession bachelor (nutrition and health)
- Food science graduate
- Head brewer graduate of the Scandinavian School of Brewing ApS
- Diploma Master Brewer graduate of the Scandinavian School of Brewing ApS
- Road transport operator examination

If you have completed another education than the ones listed above, you may still be eligible for exemption from the test. If your education included instruction in, for instance, Danish food legislation, Danish VAT and tax legislation, the Working Environment Act, the Danish Preparedness Act and the restaurant and Hotel Act, you may be exempt from the requirement to submit to the test.
