Executive Order on average adjusters and their activities
Danish Ministry of Economic and Business Affairs
Ex. Order No 43 of 12 January 1989

Pursuant to section 13 of the Act on Average Adjusters, cf. Consolidation Act No 184 of 25 March 1988, the following is laid down:

Section 1. Average adjusters shall keep a ledger authorised by the Danish Commerce and Companies Agency (DCCA). Details of when and from whom the request for an average statement was received, the name of the ship and the nature of the average and also the date of the average's final statement and its delivery shall be entered into the ledger.

(2) The average adjuster shall keep a copy of every single average statement for at least 10 years.

(3) DCCA is entitled to acquaint itself with the content of the ledger.

Section 2. The seal used by the average adjuster in their activities shall be approved by DCCA.

Section 3. In the event of an average adjuster's appointment being withdrawn or put on hold, the ledger and copies of average statements shall be kept in accordance with DCCA regulations. The seal used in the activities shall be handed over to DCCA.

Section 4. Complaints about an average adjuster delaying work entrusted to him may be brought before DCCA, which can set a deadline before which the work shall be completed. If this deadline is disregarded without a valid reason, DCCA may remove the work from the average adjuster, who will then not be paid for the part of the work already completed.

Section 5. If an average statement is amended by a court, the average adjuster shall bring this into agreement with the judgment free of charge.

Section 6. Infringement of section 1(1) and (2) and of sections 2, 3 and 5 shall be subject to a fine.

Section 7. This Executive Order shall enter into force on 1 February 1989.

(2) Executive Order No 399 of 2 December 1966 on average adjusters and their activities is repealed.
